

How to install the distribution box s mounting rails

Extend the rail until it contacts the rear flange and tighten screws to secure the rail.

Step 4: Check Stability Ensure the rails are level, firmly attached, and free of inclination or looseness. This prevents the distribution box from tilting or shifting during installation.

Step 5: Install the Distribution Box Once the rails are secured, place the distribution box onto the rails, aligning it with the mounting hardware. Tighten any expansion bolts or screws to fix the box in place.

Step 6: Final Checks Verify that the rails and box are stable and properly aligned. Ensure there is enough space around the box for ventilation and maintenance. Confirm that the installation meets safety and accessibility requirements.
