

How to install the fiber optic fusion splicer rack

- Align Fibers in the Splicer:** Place each fiber in the V-groove of the fusion splicer, ensuring proper orientation and alignment using the splicer's imaging system.
- Perform Fusion:** Activate the splicer to create an electric arc that melts and fuses the fiber ends together. The splicer will automatically check for splice quality and signal integrity.
- Protect the Splice:** Place the fused fiber in a splice protection sleeve and secure it in a fiber splice tray within the rack or enclosure.

Splice Tray and Cable Management Install fiber splice trays inside the rack, ensuring fibers are neatly routed and excess lengths are coiled without exceeding minimum bend radius. Use tray slots or compartments to separate individual fibers and prevent stress or damage. Label fibers clearly for easy identification and future maintenance.
