Label the wire as “unused” to avoid confusion in the future (). Do not leave bare ends exposed inside the box, as this can create a shock hazard (). If possible, remove any wire segments that are fully accessible, especially during renovations, to reduce clutter and potential hazards ().

Safety Checks

Before powering the distribution box: Perform a visual inspection to ensure no wires are pinched or touching metal parts. Use a multimeter to verify proper connections and absence of short circuits (). Ensure all breakers and protective devices are correctly installed and functional.
