

How to patch a small square fiber optic cable

6. **Cable Management and Labeling** Coil any extra cable neatly on a spool without overlapping or hanging. Label both ends of the patch cable with the optical path name and code for easy identification and future maintenance .
7. **Test the Connection** Use an optical power meter or VFL to verify the connection. The power should meet the expected thresholds (e.g., less than -22dB at the splitter exit and less than -23dB at the user...
