

How to place cable heads inside the distribution box



AI Overview

To connect a cable head to a distribution box, the main power cable is first connected to the main MCB, then routed through protective devices, with neutral and earth properly linked to their respective busbars.

Step-by-Step Connection Process

- 1. Safety First** Always turn off the main power supply before starting any wiring work. Use insulated tools, gloves, and safety gear to prevent electrical hazards ().
- 2. Identify Input and Output** The cable head (incoming power) typically has three wires: phase (live), neutral, and earth. Identify the main MCB (double-pole for single-phase systems) in the distribution box. This is where the incoming phase and neutral wires will connect ().
- 3. Connect the Phase Wire** Connect the phase wire from the cable head to the input terminal of the main MCB. Ensure the connection is tight and secure to prevent overheating or arcing ().
- 4. Connect the Neutral Wire** Connect the neutral wire from the cable head to the neutral busbar in the distribution box. If an RCCB is installed, the neutral wire may first pass through the RCCB before connecting to the neutral busbar ().
- 5. Connect the Earth Wire** Connect the earth wire to the earth busbar. If the distribution box has a metallic body, ensure it is also bonded to the earth busbar for safety ().
- 6. Connect Output Circuits** From the main MCB, connect the output to the input of the RCCB (if used). Then, connect the output of the RCCB to the load MCBs. Single-pole MCBs are used for individual circuits, while double-pole MCBs may be used for special loads ().
- 7. Organize and Label** Arrange wires neatly inside the box to avoid tangling. Label each circuit for easy identification and future maintenance ().
- 8. Final Checks** Verify all connections are tight and correctly placed. Ensure no bare wires are exposed. Turn on the main supply and test each circuit for proper operation ().
