Installing Optical Modules

- Identify the correct slot: Confirm the port type (SFP, SFP+, QSFP) and fiber type (single-mode or multimode) matches the module.
- Remove dust covers: Gently remove dust plugs from both the module and the port without touching the optical surfaces.
- Align and insert: Slide the module horizontally into the port, pressing firmly until the locking mechanism engages. You may hear a slight "click" indicating proper seating.
- Connect fiber cables: After the module is seated, insert the fiber jumper carefully, ensuring correct TX/RX orientation. A tactile snap confirms full insertion.
- Verify connection: Check the port status LED; green indicates a successful link.

Removing Optical Modules

- Disconnect fiber cables: Always unplug the fiber jumper before removing the module to prevent damage to the connectors or module.
- Release the latch: Flip open the pull-tab, press the actuator button, or release the bale-clasp depending on the module's latching mechanism.
- Pull out horizontally: Gently remove the module without forcing it, which could deform the port's internal spring or damage the module.
- Replace dust covers: Immediately cover unused modules and ports to prevent dust contamination.
