

How to set the MTU value after connecting to a fiber optic router

Adjust the MTU Value: Enter the desired MTU value. Start with the ISP-recommended value or test using ping commands to find the largest packet size that does not require fragmentation.

Testing the Optimal MTU To find the best MTU for your connection:

On Windows, open Command Prompt and use: `ping -f -l [packet size]`. Reduce the packet size incrementally until you no longer see the "packet needs to be fragmented" message. Add 28 bytes to account for headers to determine the correct MTU for your router.
