

How to set up a router without fiber optic connection

Extending Coverage: If Wi-Fi signals are weak in certain areas, use Wi-Fi extenders or mesh systems. Mesh networks consist of multiple nodes that create a seamless Wi-Fi network, ideal for larger homes or multi-floor spaces.

Powerline Adapters: These adapters use your home's electrical wiring to transmit internet signals. Connect one adapter to your router and another to the device you want to connect, providing a wired-like connection without running Ethernet cables.
