

How to use two routers with one fiber optic cable

You can connect two routers to a single fiber optic connection by linking the second router to the first router, either in Access Point mode or via LAN-to-WAN, to extend coverage or create a separate network segment. 1. LAN-to-WAN Connection

Step 1: Connect the fiber modem (ONT) to the WAN port of your primary router and configure it with your ISP settings.
Step 2: Connect an Ethernet cable from a LAN port on the primary router to the WAN port of the secondary router.
Step 3: Configure the secondary router in Access Point (AP) mode or Bridge mode to avoid double NAT. If AP mode is unavailable, leaving it in router mode will create a double NAT scenario, which may affect some applications.
Use Case: Ideal for creating a separate network segment or extending wired connections for specific devices.

2. LAN-to-LAN Connection

Step 1: Connect an Ethernet cable from a LAN port on the primary router to a LAN port on the secondary router.
Step 2: Disable DHCP on the secondary router to prevent IP conflicts.
Step 3: Assign a static IP to the secondary router within the same subnet as the primary router.
Use Case: Best for extending Wi-Fi coverage while keeping a single network for all devices.

Configuration Tips

Access Point Mode: Activating AP mode on the secondary router simplifies setup and avoids double NAT.
IP Address Management: Ensure the secondary router has a static IP in the same subnet but outside the primary router's DHCP range.
