

How to wire a distribution box that is not grounded

The most common and simplest solution for an ungrounded circuit is to install a Ground-Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) device. Electrical grounding is a fundamental safety mechanism that provides a low-resistance route for fault current to return to the source and trip a circuit breaker or fuse. This pathway prevents metal casings of appliances and tools from becoming energized with hazardous voltage during an internal. Here are the steps on how to ground a power distribution box: 1.
