

How to wire a four-core wire junction box

- Organize and Close the Box** Neatly arrange the wires inside the box to avoid stress or bending. Close the junction box cover securely to protect the connections from dust, moisture, and accidental contact.
- Test the Circuit** Once all connections are made and the box is closed, turn the power back on and test the circuit to ensure proper operation.
