

How to wire the neutral connection in the distribution box

Connect the Incoming Neutral: Strip 10–15 mm of insulation from the incoming neutral wire. Insert it into the inlet terminal of the neutral bus bar and tighten the screw to ensure a solid connection . If the main switch has a leakage protector, connect the incoming neutral to the main switch first, then to the neutral bus bar .

Connect Branch Circuits: Strip the insulation from each outgoing neutral wire and insert it into the corresponding outlet terminal on the neutral bus bar. Tighten each screw securely. Only one wire should be connected per terminal to avoid poor contact or overheating .

Secure and Insulate: Wrap each connection point with insulating tape if necessary to prevent accidental contact or leakage. Organize wires neatly using cable ties to maintain a clean and safe layout .

Safety and Inspection Verify that all neutral connections are tight and that no bare conductors are exposed . Use a multimeter to check continuity and ensure proper connection to the neutral bus bar . Confirm that the neutral bus bar is isolated from the metal chas...
