Consistency: Within a single project or building, maintain uniform installation height with a permissible deviation of ± 10 mm to facilitate systematic management.

IEC 61439 and BS 7671: Recommend distribution boards be installed between 1 meter and 1.8 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for accessibility.

GB50303-2002 (China): Specifies the bottom of fixed stainless steel enclosures should be 1.3–1.5 meters above ground, considering ergonomic operation.

Inspection and Maintenance: Ensure level and stable installation, proper cable entry, and grounding according to local codes.
