Minimum bend radius should follow manufacturer specifications. Use figure-8 loops when laying cable on surfaces to prevent twisting. For vertical risers, clamp cables at frequent intervals to support weight and prevent long-term stress. Ensure the installation area is free of sharp objects or debris that could damage the cable sheath. Standards and Testing Follow international standards such as TIA-568, ISO/IEC 11801, IEC 61300-3-35, and ITU-T recommendations for optical budgets and performance. Pre-terminated MPO/MTP trunks can reduce installation errors. After installation, perform OTDR and OLTS testing to verify continuity, loss, and overall network integrity.
