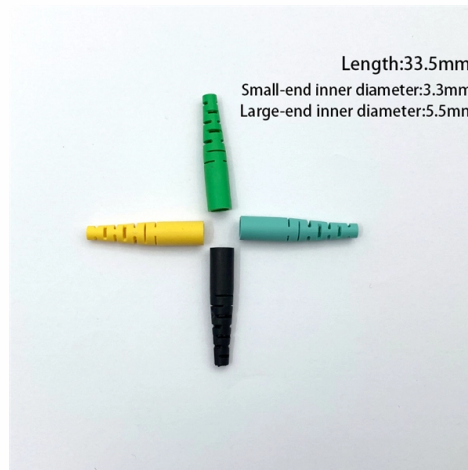


Installation of Outdoor Cable Tray Supports

For ceiling suspension, install threaded rods with a Unistrut channel to support the tray.

- Mark the Route:** Use a chalk line or laser level to mark the tray path and support points.
- Install Supports:** Secure brackets or trapeze hangers at marked points, ensuring level alignment.
- Cut and Deburr Trays:** Measure required lengths, cut trays with a hacksaw or angle grinder, and remove sharp edges to prevent cable damage.
- Place and Secure Trays:** Lift tray sections onto supports and fasten with hold-down clips or bolts. Join sections end-to-end using couplers or splice plates.
- Grounding and Bonding:** Ensure proper grounding of metal trays to prevent electrical hazards.
