- Device and Protective Case Installation** Mount devices (e.g., transceivers) onto the tray base if required. Lock protective covers or cases to prevent unauthorized access ().
- Final Checks** Verify alignment, secure all bolts, and ensure cables are properly routed. Check for compliance with load capacity and safety standards ().

- Screws, bolts, and cable ties
