An industrial switch is an active device that connects multiple cables and devices, directing data traffic intelligently. While cables plug into the switch, the switch itself is not a cable .

- Multiple port types:** RJ45, SFP fiber, serial, or M12 connectors for industrial applications .
- Redundant power supplies:** Ensures continuous operation in critical environments .
- DIN-rail mounting:** Common in industrial automation setups .
