While both wires and fiber optic cables transmit signals, the medium and signal type differ: wires use metal to conduct electricity, whereas fiber optic cables use glass or plastic fibers to transmit light. Therefore, in technical and practical usage, fiber optic assemblies are classified as cables rather than wires, reflecting their multi-component structure and purpose in transmitting optical signals over distances.
