

It is strictly forbidden to run communication optical cables along power poles



Overview

Don't attach communication cables to the metal pole or conduit that brings overhead power into the building (the service-entrance power mast). Identify the point of entrance and install the primary protector as close as possible. These guidelines cover the clearances from the power conductors, the requirements for insulation, earthing and bonding, and the protective procedures to avoid. The integration of telecommunications infrastructure with existing utility poles, a practice known as co-location, has become increasingly common due to the expanding demand for telecom services and the density of 5G towers required for optimal service. However, recent incidents have highlighted. Do you have communication lines attached to your poles or running near your underground electric cables?

Have telecom companies asked to install 5G antennas on your poles, possibly even above the primary lines?

Are you confident there's proper separation between transformer tanks and communication. These rules are referring primarily to “strand and lash” cables lashed to a wire messenger. Some exceptions exist for ADSS (all-dielectric self-supporting) cables which may be installed in the power space or telecom space.
