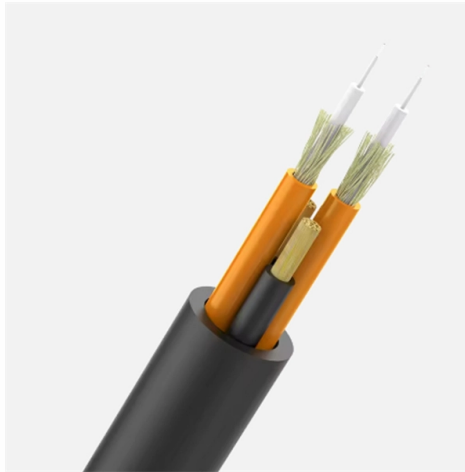

- 5. Stealth or Camouflaged Towers** Stealth towers are designed to blend with the environment, such as in UNESCO-sensitive tourist areas or residential neighborhoods. These towers may resemble trees, flagpoles, or other structures to minimize visual impact while supporting antennas and transmission equipment.
