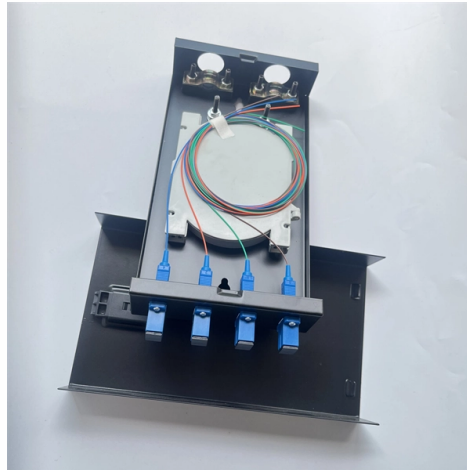

- Fuse Box:** An older type using fuses instead of breakers to protect circuits.
- Power Distribution Units (PDUs):** Often used in industrial or IT environments to distribute power to multiple devices efficiently.

Materials and Installation

Distribution boxes are typically made from engineering thermoplastics like polycarbonate or ASA, or metal enclosures such as epoxy-coated or powder-coated steel for durability. They can be installed indoors (homes, offices) or outdoors (exposed environments), with outdoor boxes requiring higher IP protection ratings to withstand weather condition...
