Creating a 90-degree elbow in an electrical cable tray, often called a "fabricated" or "mitered" bend, involves cutting, bending, and fastening a straight section of tray. The most common method involves creating two 45-degree cuts to form a 90-degree angle. The length of the bottom side (bottom diagonal) after bending the cable tray should be equal to the width of the cable. The production of cable tray elbows requires the following steps: 1.
