- Load Capacity**
 - Per Unit Load:** Racks must support an average of 15.9 kg (35 lbs) per EIA unit. For example, a 4U drawer can hold up to 63.6 kg (140 lbs).
- Frame Construction:** Racks are typically made from sheet steel or aluminum with torsionally stiff frames, chamfered edges, and integral system holes for flexible equipment attachment.
- Airflow and Cooling**
 - Perforation:** Front and rear doors often have 60–85% perforation to allow airflow. Roofs may have 20% perforation for heat dissipation.
- Clearances:** Minimum spacing between chassis vents and walls is 2.5 inches (6.4 cm) to ensure proper airflow.
- Power Distribution**
 - Power Requirements:** Each PDU requires a dedicated 200–240 V AC line at 30 A. Racks must accommodate PDUs in 1U or Zero-U form factors without wasting installation volume.
