Keystone Jacks: Modular connectors that can be swapped for different types of network or audio/video connections, including fiber optic or coaxial (). Fiber Optic Connectors: For optical networks, common types include LC, SC, and ST connectors, which connect fiber patch cables to transceivers or switches (). Screw or Push-in Terminals: Found in industrial or DIN rail-mounted panels, allowing tool-free or secure connections for specialized applications (). Installation and Wiring Proper installation involves several steps (): Strip the outer jacket of the network cable using a wire stripper. Arrange the individual wires according to the T568A or T568B wiring standard. Insert the wires into the corresponding IDC or keystone jack slots. Use a punch-down or small tool to secure the wires.
