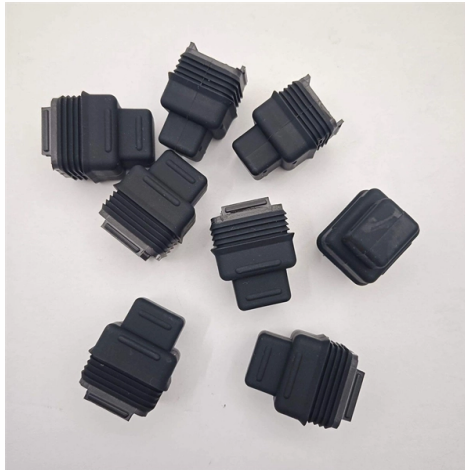


ODF frame pigtail cable routing frame

It brings together fiber splicing, patching, and cable routing in a single structure, while shielding sensitive connectors and splices from mechanical. An optical Distribution Frame (ODF) or patch panel is the starting point for optical cables, most commonly found in rack cabinets in Head End (HE)/Central Office (CO)/Point of Presence (POP)/Data Centre (DC) or smaller cabinets or enclosures.
