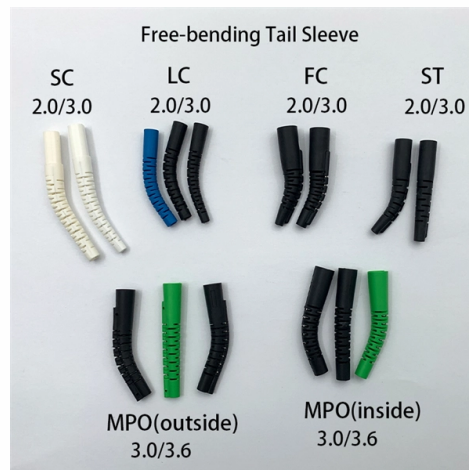


ONU fiber optic cable connection



Overview

ONU (Optical Network Unit): The ONU is installed at the customer's premises and connects the fiber optic line from the OLT to the customer's local network (such as routers, switches, and computers). It serves as the bridge for data transmission between the FTTH network and the end. ONU stands for Optical Network Unit. It integrates the reception and conversion of fiber-optic signals, translating XGSPON or XGS-PON protocol signals into Ethernet. Once the fiber-optic cable reaches your home or office, it needs to be connected to a device that can turn the light signals from the fiber into electrical signals your devices can understand. When configured in Router Mode, the ONU takes on several additional roles: Signal Conversion: Translates the optical signal from your ISP's fiber line. ONT and ONU are essentially the same. They all refer to user-side equipment in the GEAPON system.
