Rack-mounted boxes: Install brackets on both sides of the box and fix them to the designated rack position with screws. Ensure the installation direction aligns with network design requirements.

Introducing and Routing Fiber Optic Cables

Cable entry: Insert the optical cable through the designated entry hole, using a grommet or protective jacket to prevent damage.

Securing cables: Wrap tape around the fixed position of the cable to prevent loosening. Maintain the minimum bending radius specified by the manufacturer to avoid signal loss.

Routing inside the box: Use spools, bending radius clips, and cable ties to organize the fiber paths. Ensure sufficient slack so that drawer-style panels or front panels can be fully extended without tension on the fibers.

Splicing: Fusion splice the incoming fibers to pigtails or pre-terminated j...
