Keep it away from flammable or corrosive materials and ensure proper ventilation to avoid overheating. Wiring and Protection Inside the distribution box, neatly arrange wires and connect phase, neutral, and ground terminals correctly. Each circuit should have its own circuit breaker or fuse to protect against overloads and short circuits . Use the correct wire gauge and ensure all connections are tight. Include surge protection if necessary, and label all circuits for easy identification during maintenance .
