To connect a router to a switch and a PoE switch, link the router's LAN port to the switch's uplink or regular port, then connect the PoE switch to the network to power devices while ensuring proper configuration.

Understanding the Devices

- Router:** Connects your internal network to the internet, provides NAT, DHCP, and firewall services, and manages IP addressing for devices on the network.
- Switch:** Expands the number of Ethernet ports, allowing multiple devices to communicate within the local network.
- PoE Switch:** Provides both data and power over Ethernet to devices like IP cameras, access points, or VoIP phones, following standards such as IEEE 802.3af/at/bt.

Connection Steps

- Preparation:** Ensure all devices (router, switch, PoE switch, and cables) are functional. Plan the network layout to minimize cable lengths and optimize device placement.
- Cabling:** Connect the router's LAN port to an available port on the standard switch. Connect the PoE switch to the network via its uplink or regular port, either directly to the router or through the standard switch depending on your topology. If cascading multiple PoE switches, avoid excessive layers to prevent performance degradation.
- Power On:** Turn on the router first, then the switches. Wait for indicator lights to stabilize, signaling normal operation.
- Configuration:**
 - Router:** Access the management interface via a browser (e.g., 192.168.1.1), configure internet access (PPPoE, static IP, or dynamic IP), enable DHCP, and set up wireless networks if applicable.
 - PoE Switch:** If intelligent, configure port power modes, VLANs, and other settings through its management interface.
- Mixing PoE and Non-PoE Devices:** Active PoE switches detect whether a connected device supports PoE and only supply power if needed. Non-PoE devices will receive data only. Avoid using passive PoE switches with non-PoE devices to prevent dama...
