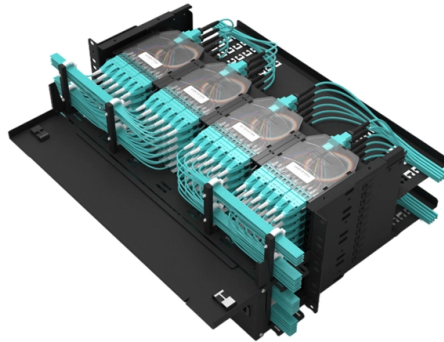


Power cable tray laying sleeve

Cable Tray Selection and Preparation

For outdoor or exposed installations, protect the sleeve from moisture and environmental factors during installation.

Cable Handling and Pulling

Before pulling cables through the sleeve, verify that the cable has been acclimatized if stored in extreme temperatures, and that the drum is positioned correctly to avoid twisting or torsion. Maintain the minimum bending radius as specified by the cable manufacturer, and avoid sharp bends at the tray exit or entry points. Use pulling equipment or rollers to reduce mechanical stress and prevent sidewall pressure that could damage the cable insulation.

Securing and Spacing

Once the cable is through the sleeve, secure it to the tray using cable ties or clamps at regular intervals to prevent movement and sagging. Maintain proper spacing between cables to allow heat dissipation and avoid ampacity derating due to bundling. For high-current power cables, consider the thermal effects of the tray and ensure the installation does not exceed the cable's rated ampacity.
