- MCB (Miniature Circuit Breaker):** Protects individual circuits from overcurrent due to overload or short circuit. Phase wires are routed through MCBs, which automatically disconnect the circuit if current exceeds the rated limit.
- RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker):** Detects leakage currents and protects against electric shock. Both phase and neutral wires pass through the RCCB, which trips when leakage is detected.
- Fuses:** Provide additional overcurrent protection, typically installed before the main isolator or energy meter in some setups.
- SPD (Surge Protection Device):** Optional device to protect against voltage spikes, connected in parallel with the phase and neutral lines.
