Suitable for small server rooms or office IT setups. Metered PDUs: Include local or remote power metering to monitor electrical usage, helping prevent overloads and optimize energy efficiency. Switched PDUs: Allow remote control of individual outlets, enabling scheduled power cycling or remote rebooting of equipment.
