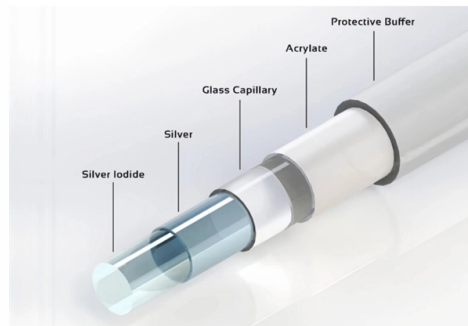


Requirements for the enclosure of secondary distribution boxes



Overview

It stipulates requirements for enclosure materials, installation dimensions, the mandatory "one equipment, one switch, one RCD" rule, mechanical structure, earthing systems, component selection and marking. secondary unit substation is a close-coupled assembly consisting of enclosed primary high. The words boxes/enclosures have the same meaning and are used. Most modern secondary networks are operated at AC rated voltage of 100-120 or 230-240 volts, at the frequency of 50 or 60 hertz. Operating voltage, required number of phases (three-phase or single-phase) and required reliability dictate topology and configuration of the network.
