Overview of a Residential Distribution Box A residential distribution box (also called a consumer unit or breaker panel) is an enclosure that receives incoming electricity from the utility and distributes it to multiple circuits in a home through protective devices such as miniature circuit breakers (MCBs), residual-current devices (RCDs), or residual-current breakers with overcurrent protection (RCBOs). It typically includes a main switch, phase busbar, neutral bar, earth bar, and space for wiring and cable entries. Circuit Breakers in Residential Panels MCBs protect individual circuits against overload and short-circuit currents. Each MCB is selected based on the conductor size, load type, and installation method. They do not provide protection against earth leakage, so in circuits where shock protection is required, an RCD or RCBO is added. RCDs/RCCBs detect current imbalances between live and neutral conductors, reducing the risk of electric shock and fire caused by earth leakage. Common configurations include: RCCB plus MCBs: One RCD protects multiple MCB circuits. RCBO per circuit: Each circuit has combined overcurrent and residual-current protection, offering better fault selectivity. Internal Structure Inside a residential distribution box, the incoming supply connects to the main switch, which then feeds the phase busbar. The busbar distributes current to the MCBs, while the neutral and earth bars provide return paths and grounding. Some boxes also include surge protective devices (SPDs) for transient voltage protection. The layout ensures safe separation of live parts, proper heat dissipation, and space for future expansion. In TN earthing systems, upstream fuses may protect the installation, while in TT syste...
