Overview of Residential Distribution Boxes A residential distribution box (DB box) is an enclosure that safely distributes electrical power from a single input to multiple circuits in a home. It houses protective devices such as miniature circuit breakers (MCBs), residual current devices (RCCBs/RCDs), and RCBOs, along with busbars, neutral and earth bars, and sometimes surge protective devices (SPDs) for lightning or fault protection. The enclosure is typically made from thermoplastics like PC or ASA or coated metals for durability and safety.

Circuit Breaker Types and Models

- Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs)** Protect individual circuits against overload and short-circuit currents. Common residential ratings: 6A, 10A, 16A, 20A, 32A depending on the load and wiring. MCBs do not provide residual-current protection, so they are often paired with RCCBs or RCBOs.
- Residual Current Circuit Breakers (RCCBs/RCDs)** Detect earth leakage currents to prevent electric shocks. Typically installed to protect multiple MCB circuits in a split-load configuration. Commonly rated for 30mA sensitivity for personal protection.
- RCBOs (Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent Protection)** Combine overcurrent protection and residual-current protection in a single device. Often used for critical circuits to ensure that a single fault does not disconnect multiple unrelated circuits.

Selection Criteria for Circuit Breaker Models

- Rated Current:** Match the MCB or RCBO to the expected load of the circuit.
- Short-Circuit Capacity:** Ensure the breaker can handle the maximum fault current available.
- Number of Ways:** Choose a distribution box with enough slots for current circuits plus future expansion.
- Protective Strategy:** Decide between MCB + RCCB combination or RCBO per circuit...
