

Restore fiber optic switch to factory settings

You can reset a fiber optic switch using either a soft reset (power cycle) or a hard reset (factory reset), depending on the issue and desired outcome.

Soft Reset (Power Cycle) A soft reset is the simplest method and is often sufficient to resolve minor connectivity issues or temporary glitches:

Hard Reset (Factory Reset) A hard reset restores the device to its original factory settings and should be used if a soft reset does not resolve the issue:

- Backup settings:** Note any custom configurations such as Wi-Fi names, passwords, or port forwarding rules, as these will be erased.
- Locate the reset button:** Most fiber devices have a small recessed button on the back or bottom.
- Press and hold the reset button:** Use a paperclip or pin to hold the button for 10–15 seconds while the device is powered on.
- Release and wait:** Let the device reboot fully. This may take several minutes, and the indicator lights will cycle during the process.
- Reconfigure settings:** After the reset, you may need to re-enter network settings or contact your ISP to reactivate the device.

Precautions Do not unplug the fiber cable unless instructed by your ISP, as it is fragile and can be damaged. Disconnect connected devices to prevent accidental data loss during the reset. Notify other users on the network, as the reset will temporarily interrupt internet access. Check with your ISP if unsure about the reset procedure or if the device requires reactivation. A...
