- Support:** Additional supports may be required at bends to maintain structural integrity and prevent sagging.
- Cable Pulling:** Smooth bends facilitate easier cable pulling and reduce stress on the cables.
- Installation Space:** The available horizontal and vertical space may dictate whether a standard 90° fitting, adjustable elbow, or custom bend is used.

Best Practices

- Use pre-fabricated fittings whenever possible for consistency and safety.
- When bending on-site, gradually form the bend to avoid kinks or sharp angles.
- Verify that the bend does not exceed the cable's minimum bending radius.
- Add supports near the bend to maintain alignment.
