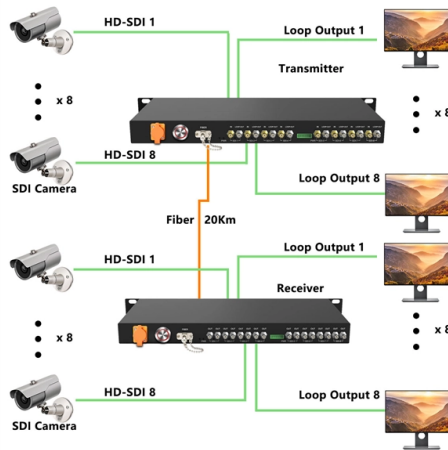


## SAS as an alternative to Fibre Channel



### Overview

In this article, we examine the typical challenges involved in implementing and operating Fibre Channel networks – and why alternatives such as SAS (Serial Attached SCSI) or iSCSI are often the smarter choice. While Fibre Channel may still be useful in certain high-performance environments, many IT. Area Networks (SANs) with the idea of purchasing native Fibre Channel tape drives or libraries.
