Connecting Two Routers to One Fiber Modem

You can connect two routers to a single fiber modem (ONT), but the setup depends on your goals:

- Cascading Routers (Router-to-Router)** – Connect the WAN port of the second router to a LAN port of the primary router. The primary router manages the internet connection, while the second router can operate in Access Point (AP) mode to extend Wi-Fi coverage or create a separate network segment. This is the most common method for home networks ().
- Using Multiple Ethernet Ports on the ONT** – Some fiber modems have multiple Ethernet ports that can assign separate public IPs. Each router connects directly to the ONT, creating independent networks. This is less common and often requires ISP support ().
- Using a Managed Switch** – If your goal is mainly to expand wired connections, connect a switch to the primary router and then connect the second router (in AP mode) or other devices to the switch. This avoids double NAT issues and is cost-effective ().
