- Proper Cable Sizing:** Ensure that all cables are sized according to the load they will carry, considering both continuous and intermittent loads.
- Compliance with Standards:** Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or equivalent) and use certified components to maintain safety and reliability.
- Labeling and Maintenance:** Clearly label all circuits and maintain organized cable routing to simplify troubleshooting and future upgrades.
