

Signal Cable Junction Box Restoration Procedure

Step 4: Cable Termination and Jointing Strip and prepare conductors carefully, ensuring no damage to the core. Use appropriate connectors or lugs and crimp them properly for secure connections. For armoured cables, ensure the armour is properly spread and bonded to the junction box. Apply heat-shrink or resin cast insulation for protection and mechanical stability. Maintain segregation of signal types (AI, AO, DI, DO, power) to prevent interference.

Step 5: Grounding and Shielding Verify the earth stud and grounding connection are intact and measure earth bonding resistance. Terminate cable shields or screens properly to maintain signal integrity.
