Accessibility: The mounting height should allow users to read labels, operate breakers, and perform maintenance without excessive bending or stretching.

Environmental Protection: Install boxes in dry, ventilated areas away from water, dust, or corrosive environments. Outdoor boxes should meet appropriate IP/NEMA ratings.

Standards Compliance: Follow IEC 61439, BS 7671, and NEC 2023 codes for panel selection, installation, and working space requirements to ensure safety and regulatory compliance.
