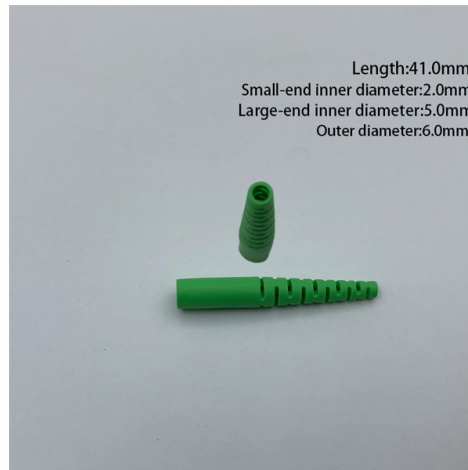


Standard for New Outdoor Distribution Boxes

Outdoor distribution boxes must comply with weatherproofing, electrical, and safety standards such as NEC Article 312, UL 50/50E, and NEMA/IP ratings, with local adaptations like Hong Kong's COP 101 for site-specific requirements. These requirements ensure safety, reliability, and compliance with local statutory regulations.

Material and Construction Requirements

Enclosure Materials: Aluminum (5052-H32), stainless steel (304 or 316), or high-quality ABS plastic for corrosion and UV resistance.

Sealing: Closed-cell neoprene gaskets and RTV silicone to prevent water and dust ingress.

Thermal Management: Ventilation vents or thermal regulation features to manage heat buildup.

Mounting: Surface-mounted with stainless steel fasteners; minimum depth calculated per conductor size and NEC 312.9.

Finish: Powder-coated or epoxy dustproof coatings for durability and environmental protection.

Electrical and Safety Features

Bus Bars: Copper or aluminum with ampacity rated for continuous load (e.g., 400A at 40°C ambient), temperature rise
