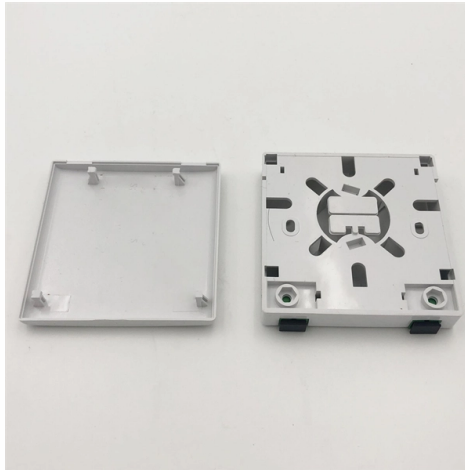


## Switch Router Optical Port



### AI Overview

Optical ports on routers and switches are configured using pluggable transceivers, wavelength assignment, and amplifier settings to enable high-speed, point-to-point or DWDM connectivity.

**Key Components**

**Pluggable Optical Modules:** Modern routers and switches use QSFP-DD or DCO transceivers to provide optical connectivity. These modules can integrate amplification (QDD Optical Line System) and support multiple coherent channels over a single fiber span.

**Optical Ports and Subports:** Each optical module typically exposes two main ports—COM and Line—mapped to OTS (Optical Transmission Section) controllers, often referred to as subport 0 and subport 1. This mapping allows precise control over signal amplification and wavelength routing.

**Wavelength Assignment:** For DWDM or multi-channel links, each channel must be configured with a specific wavelength or frequency according to the module's operating range. Passive MUX/DEMUX cables are used to combine or separate channels.

**Configuration Steps**

**Verify Privileges:** Ensure you have administrative access to the router CLI.

**Identify Controller:** Determine the OTS controller identifier for the optical module (e.g., 0/0/2/1/0).

**Set Amplifier Mode:** Configure the amplifier operational mode to either manual (set gain) or powermode (set output power).

**Assign Wavelengths:** Configure each channel's wavelength according to the supported range for the module and fiber type.

**Verify Configuration:** Use commands like `show controllers ots` to check the operational state, LED status, and alarms.

**Operational Considerations**

**Monitoring:** Pluggable DCO transceivers provide real-time visibility of optical performance, including signal quality and fiber characteristics, directly to the router.

**Integration with IP/MPLS:** Routed Optical Networking allows routers to forward traffic based on IP/MPLS while maintaining direct visibility of optical layer performance.

**Amplification and Reach:** QDD OLS modules extend fiber reach and increase bandwidth while reducing power dissipation, making them suitable for...
