When excessive current flows, the MCB trips, interrupting the power flow. After resolving the issue, the breaker can be reset by switching it back on. These breakers are arranged in columns and connected to the busbars, distributing power to different circuits such as lighting, outlets, and appliances. Busbars and Connectors Busbars are metal strips, usually copper or aluminum, that carry current from the main switch to individual circuit breakers. They provide a reliable connection point for all circuits. Neutral and earth busbars connect the respective wires from each circuit, ensuring proper grounding and completing the electrical circuit. Connectors secure wires to the busbars, maintaining stable and safe connections. Residual Current Devices (RCDs) and RCBOs RCDs detect leakage currents and cut off power to prevent electric shocks, while RCBOs combine overcurrent protection with residual-current protection for individual circuits. These devices enhance safety by protecting both people and equipment.
