

The optical module needs to be re-inserted after a power outage



Overview

The solution is to unplug the fiber and reinsert it into the SFP module interface until a “click” sound is heard, indicating the fiber connector and SFP module are properly connected. If the optical module is installed on a GE port, run the `display interface GigabitEthernet x/x/x` command to view port information when the optical module is inserted, including the rate and wavelength. Have you ever experienced an unexpected network outage due to the failure of an SFP/SFP+ optical transceiver?

Network outages can bring your ability to communicate and work to a halt, and your IT team will likely be frantically looking for a solution. It is important to understand how to. The SFP/Media Converter is designed for easy use in optical fiber transmission. When the connection does not work as expected after we set it up according to the Installation Guide, we need to do some troubleshooting. I have a problem with the SFP module on my C3750 Switch. There is a File Server connected to one of the ports on the module (there are 3 Gi ports) and whenever there is a power outage the module stops working and there is no access to the File Server, I thought the port that the SFP module was.
