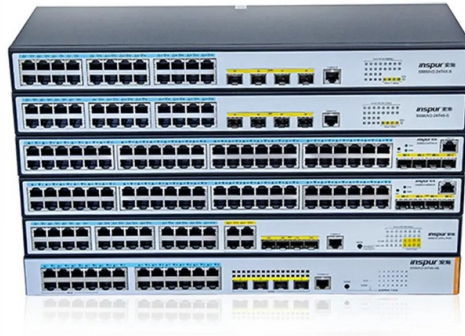


Three-level electrical distribution box for building construction

Overview of the Three Levels

Primary Distribution Box (Main Distribution Board): This is the main hub connected directly to the transformer, typically receiving 0.4kV from the low-voltage side. It does not supply power directly to devices but distributes electricity to secondary boards. Key components include isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) to ensure overall circuit safety. These boxes are often designed for outdoor use with rainproof tops and copper busbars for optimal conductivity.

Secondary Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Board): These boards serve specific buildings, floors, or zones. They handle three-phase power and connect to larger loads such as motors or machinery. Secondary boards include larger three-phase circuit breakers and are designed with dual-door protection, durable coatings, and rainproof features for outdoor environments. They also implement RCDs to provide intermediate-level protection.

Tertiary Distribution Box (Switch Box or Unit-Level Box): The tertiary box is the final distribution point, supplying 220V single-phase power to individual devices or household systems. It follows strict safety standards, often summarized as "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box," ensuring independent protection for each appliance. Tertiary boxes may be fixed or portable and form part of a two-layer protection strategy, with RCDs installed both at the tertiary and secondary levels.

Safety and Design Principles

Two-Level Protection: Leakage protection is installed at both the main and tertiary levels to prevent electrical hazards.
