

Tunnel Cable Tray Installation Process

Ensure sufficient clearance for horizontal adjustments and secure all nuts and washers to maintain stability. Supports should be spaced according to tray type and load, typically every 1.5 to 3 meters for ladder trays.

Installation Procedure

Layout and Marking: Mark the tunnel ceiling or walls according to the approved layout.

Mount Supports: Install vertical hangers and cross members, ensuring they are level and aligned.

Attach Cable Trays: Secure trays to the support system using tray clips, allowing for minor horizontal adjustments.

Connect Sections: Use appropriate fittings to join tray sections, maintaining continuity and alignment.

Check Clearances: Ensure adequate spacing from other services, ventilat...
