Adjustable heights and widths to accommodate non-standard or future expansion racks. Seismic-rated stands for stability in regions with potential environmental risks, ensuring independent support from the raised floor (EAE Electric). Pre-fabricated or modular designs that can be assembled on-site, allowing flexible deployment and scalability (Legrand).

Containment and Airflow Management Cold aisle enclosures are installed directly on the rack or supported by ceiling grids, forming a continuous corridor for cold air (Vertiv). Hot aisle chimneys or open plenum systems direct hot exhaust air to CRAC or PAHU units, maintaining separation from cold air (EAE Electric). Dummy panels can be deployed in unused rack spaces to maintain airflow separation and prevent hotspots (EAE Electric). Raised floor systems with perforated tiles are often used to distribute cold air efficiently to the cold aisle (OCS Group).
