Wiring and Electrical Configuration Turn off power before wiring to ensure safety. Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching load requirements. Maintain neat cable management, proper insulation, and correct breaker sizing. Each circuit should have individual protection via breakers, fuses, or surge protectors. Label all circuits clearly for safety and future maintenance. Grounding and Safety All metal parts, including the box, electrical board, and appliance casings, must be properly grounded. A protective neutral wire should be connected through a terminal board. Install a leakage protector or GFCI for additional safety. Avoid storing flammable materials inside the box to prevent fire hazards. Installation and Backfilling (for Wastewater Distribution Boxes) Excavate a hole just large enough for the box and set pipe inverts at proper elevations. Install twist-lock seals and insert pipes at least 1 inch inside the box. Backfill in two layers, tamping carefully to avoid deflection of the box walls. Ensure lid is secured and opti...
